PUBLIC DISCUSSION PORTION – OPT-IN OR OPT-OUT OF CANNABIS

With Governor Murphy’s legislation legalizing and regulating cannabis use and possession, [A-21](#) (P.L.2021,c.16), supplemental decriminalization of cannabis use, [A-1897](#) (P.L.2021,c.19), and clarification of use and penalties for individualities under the age of 21, [S-3454](#) P.L.2021,c.25), the City of Woodbury has 180 days from February 22, 2021, to adopt an ordinance in regards cultivating, manufacturing, wholesale, distribution, retail, delivery, and cannabis tax, within the City.

By August 21, 2021, the City has to take action to either prohibit or limit the number of cannabis establishments, distributors, or delivery services; the location, manner, and times of operation, and establishing civil penalties for violation of ordinance. If the City of Woodbury does not take action by August 21, 2021, any class of cannabis establishment or distributor will be permitted to operate in the municipality, and depending on the type of establishment, be considered a permitted use in certain zones. The City can also enact by ordinance a local cannabis tax that cannot exceed 2% for cannabis cultivator, manufacturer, and/or retailer; and 1% for wholesalers, if it is in the best interest of the City.

To make a decision that represents the best interests of the residents and businesses of the City of Woodbury, the City Council of the City of Woodbury will be having a Public Discussion Portion to Opt-In or Opt-Out of Cannabis at the May 12, May 26, and June 9, 2021, City Council meetings. It is important to Mayor Sickel and the entire City Council that residents have ample time and opportunity to be involved in this process. This Public Discussion Portion will be separate from the Open to the Public on Agenda Items Only and general Open to the Public Portions of the City Council meetings.

The full timeline of public participation to opt-in or opt-out cannabis goes as follows:

- May 12, 2021, City Council Meeting– 1st Public Discussion Portion on to Opt-In or Opt-Out of Cannabis
- May 26, 2021, City Council Meeting – 2nd Public Discussion Portion on to Opt-In or Opt-Out of Cannabis
- June 9, 2021, City Council Meeting – 3rd Public Discussion Portion on Opt-In or Opt-Out of Cannabis
- June 24, 2021, Planning/Zoning Board Meeting – City of Woodbury Planning and Zoning Board proposes an Ordinance to Opt-In or Opt-Out of Cannabis
- July 14, 2021, City Council Meeting – 1st Reading of the Ordinance proposed by the City of Woodbury Planning and Zoning Board
- July 28, 2021, City Council Meeting – 2nd Reading and Public Hearing on the Ordinance proposed by the City of Woodbury Planning and Zoning Board

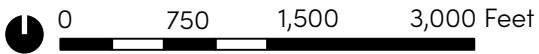

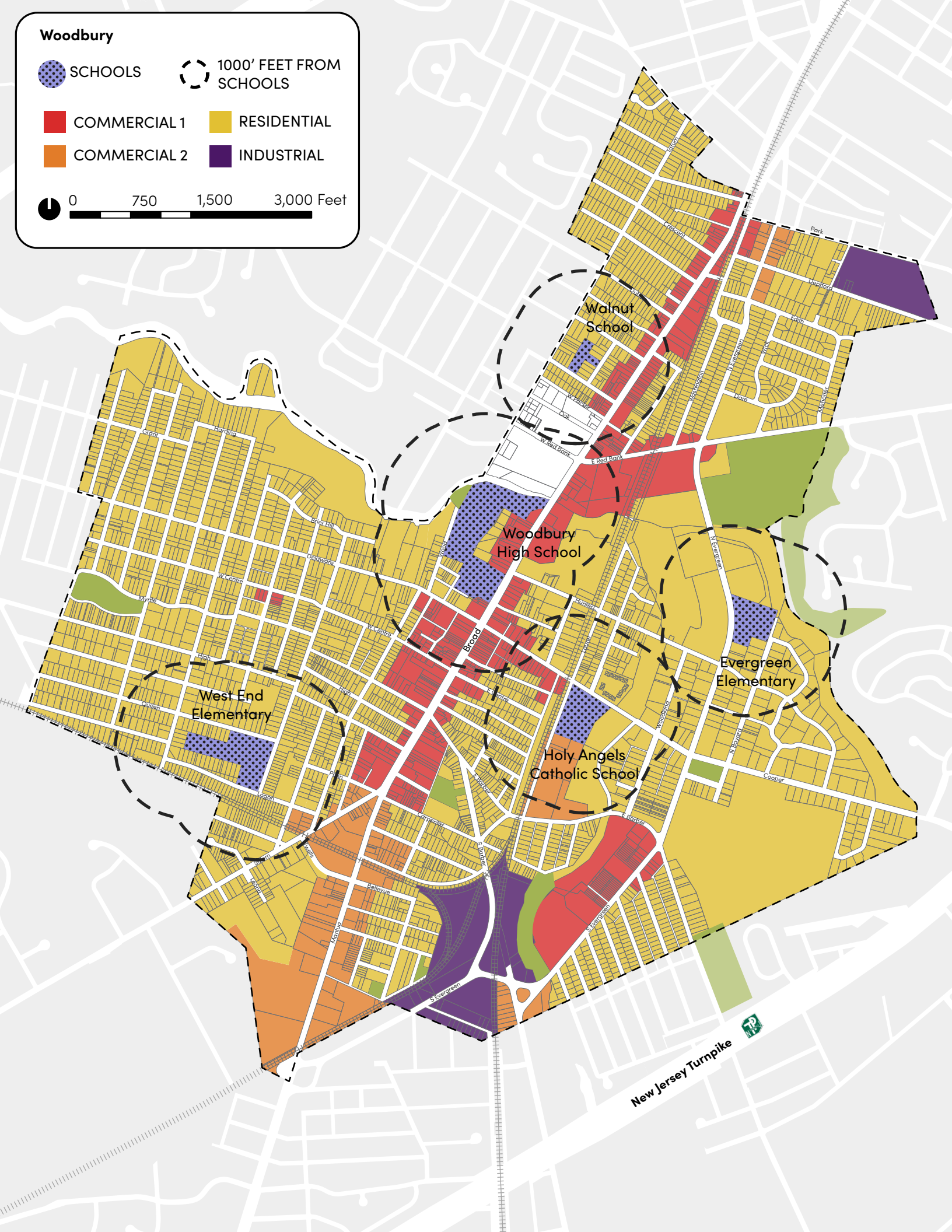

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY
AUTHORIZING A PERMIT FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAY AND AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE FOURTH OF JULY PUBLIC
FIREWORKS DISPLAY**

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury will again sponsor this year's public display of fireworks to be held at the Woodbury High School and the Frances Avenue Complex on the evening of Saturday, July 3, 2021, with the rain date to be Monday, July 5, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury is desirous of continuing the tradition of a Fourth of July public fireworks display by sponsoring said event; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury wishes to engage **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks** for the July 3, 2021 fireworks display in the amount of **\$11,500**; and

WHEREAS, the fireworks display and event is fully funded by donations and sponsorship; and

WHEREAS, such display will be supervised by competent and experienced persons in compliance with N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, and will not be a detriment to the community, but to the contrary will offer substitute for the heretofore indiscriminate and unlawful use of fireworks on the part of the individuals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, as follows:

1. Pursuant to the authority granted under N.J.S.A. 21:3-1, N.J.S.A. 21:3-3 and N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, the City Clerk and/or Administrator of the City of Woodbury be and hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver a good and sufficient license of permit to the City of Woodbury, authorizing the public display of fireworks at the Woodbury High School property and/or Frances Avenue Complex during the evening of Saturday, July 3, 2021 at approximately 9:00 p.m., eastern daylight time, under the supervision of **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks, PO Box 149, New Castle PA 16103**, a fully qualified pyrotechnical firm, the company named in the application heretofore submitted to the Fire Marshal. Said fireworks are to be delivered on Saturday, July 3, 2021 and will remain on the truck at the Woodbury High School and/or Frances Avenue Complex until set up. Said license shall be without force and effect until such time as the fireworks display company, **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks**, shall file with the Fire Marshal insurance coverage naming the City of Woodbury, the Township of West Deptford, and the Woodbury School District as additional insureds, including a statutory bond, which are satisfactory to the Solicitor, which would indemnify any person who may receive or sustain injury to his or her person or property by reason of any discharge of the fireworks in question and a Hold Harmless Agreement to the benefit of the City of Woodbury, in a form satisfactory to the Solicitor. All operations incidental to such display shall be subject to the approval of the Chief of Police and Fire Department of the City of Woodbury as required by

law; and

2. If the rain date that is established is beyond the ninety-six (96) hour limit, the fireworks will be removed from the storage area in the City and returned to the site twenty-four (24) hours prior to a new date of fireworks display. The storage area will be the middle of the Frances Avenue Fields; and

3. The Mayor, Peg Sickel, is hereby authorized to execute a contract for the fireworks display between the City of Woodbury and the fireworks provider, **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks.**

4. Any city of Woodbury permit fees are hereby waived.

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FY2022 MUNICIPAL AID PROJECT HEREINAFTER KNOWN AS RESURFACING OF WEST CENTRE STREET

WHEREAS, The City of Woodbury is in need of resurfacing the roadway, including milling and overlay, removal of curb barriers at intersections, installation of bicycle-safe inlet grates, and replacing damaged or missing concrete curbing along West Centre Street from South Jackson Street to South Broad Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has estimated the construction cost of the necessary improvements at approximately \$273,578.10 plus \$25,000 for design engineering, \$41,036.72 for construction management, inspection services, and materials testing for a total amount of \$339,614.82; and

WHEREAS, The City of Woodbury desires to prepare plans and specifications and to issue bid documents for construction in 2022, as funds become available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Council of the City of Woodbury understands that the Resurfacing of West Centre Street Project will be constructed in 2022, and the City of Woodbury formally approves the grant application for the above stated project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, City Administrator, CFO, and City Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as Application No. MA-2022-West Centre Street-00545 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Woodbury; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, City Administrator, CFO, and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Woodbury and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury has obtained a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for \$125,000 to carry out the Neighborhood Preservation Program (NPP) from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury desires to apply for, obtain and accept a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for approximately \$125,000 to carry out Year 2 of the Neighborhood Preservation Program (NPP) from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to design and implement a wide range of initiatives to restore a favorable climate for investment and to improve the quality of life for the residents and businesses of this neighborhood; and to administer and implement a DCA-approved Year 2 Neighborhood Preservation Program Implementation Plan.

WHEREAS, as a condition of the grant, the NJDCA requires that a Strategic Implementation Plan be prepared which delineates the activities of the NPP program and describes the manner in which the grant funds will be expended. The plan covers a one-year period (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021) and must be submitted to the NJDCA for review and approval prior to program implementation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury does hereby authorize the application for such a grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury recognizes and accepts that the Department may offer a lesser or greater amount and therefore, upon receipt of the grant agreement from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, does further authorize the execution of any such grant agreement; and also, upon receipt of the fully executed agreement from the Department, does further authorize the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the agreement between; and
